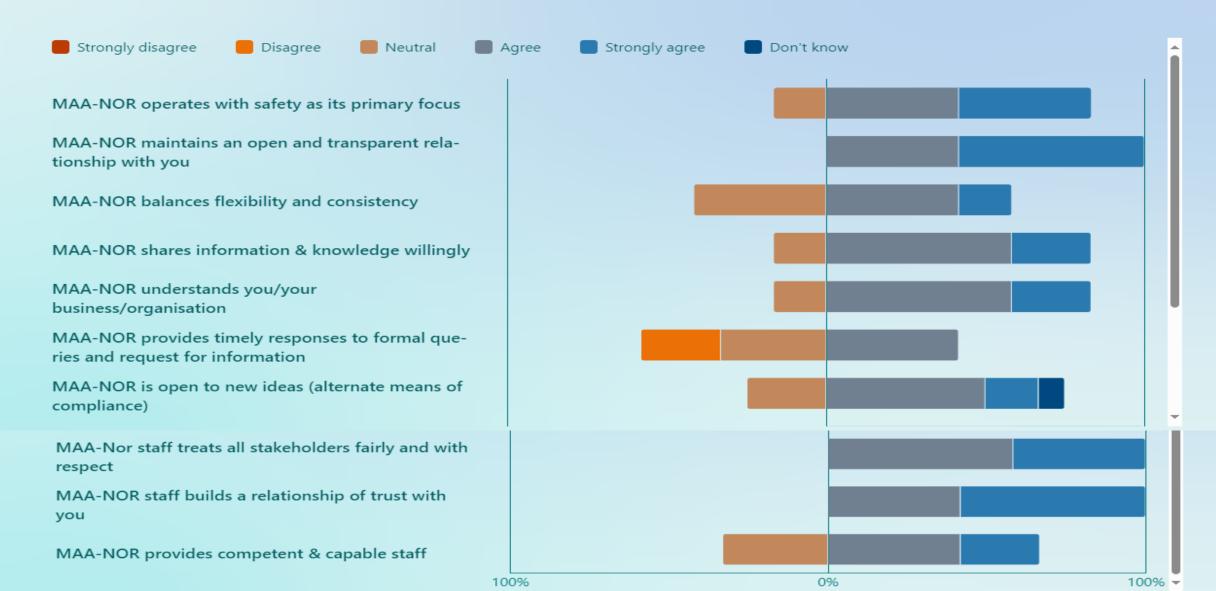
Part A Development of regulations



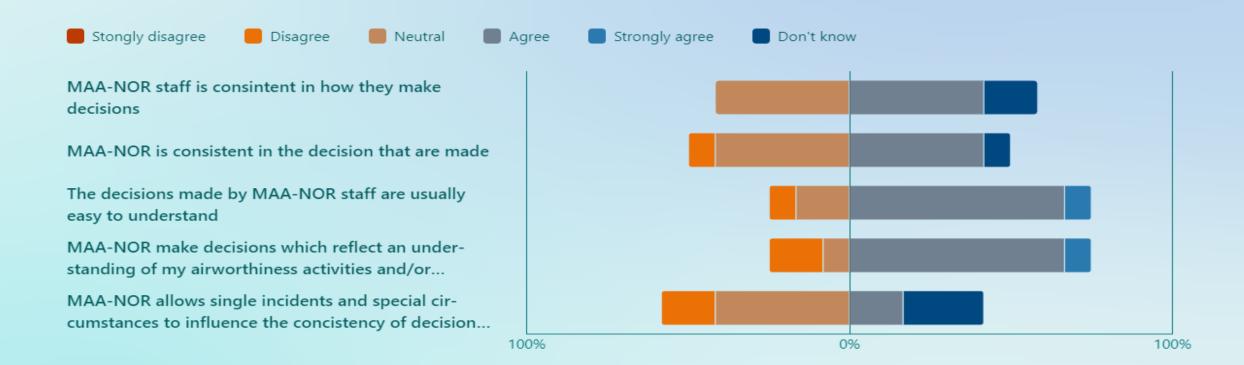
Part B - Understanding of regulations



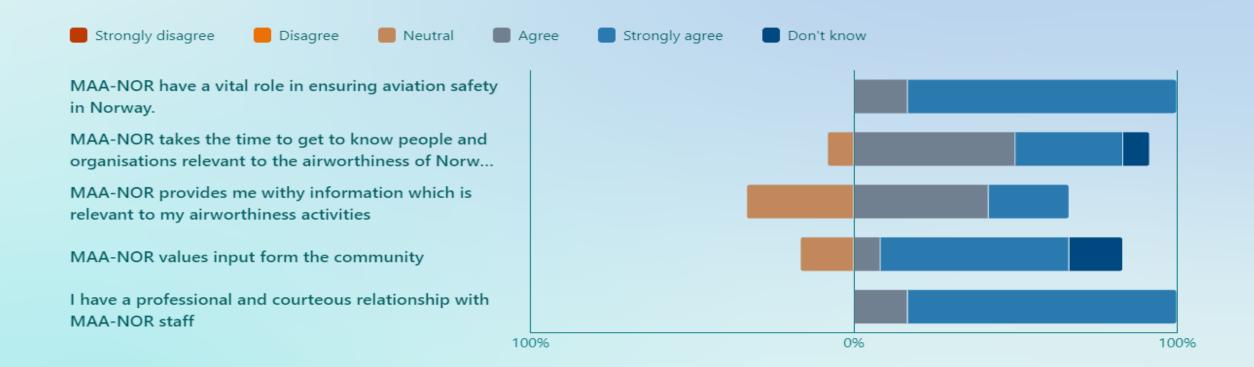
Satisfaction with relationship



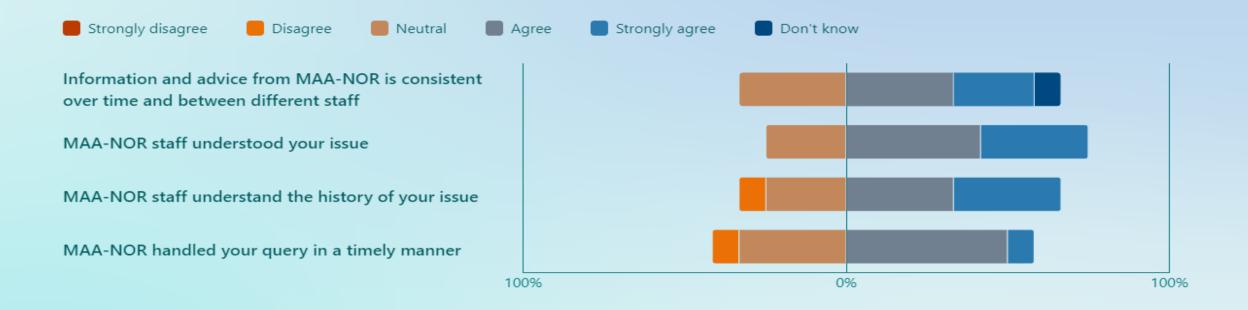

1	anonymous	Suggest MAA-NOR to invite all stakeholders to an annual conference similar to Norwegian CAA.
2	anonymous	MAA-NOR is on a steady path to establish the same strong position within Norwegian Aviation as that of the Norwegian Civil Aviation Authority. One recommendation is that MAA-NOR implements an annual conference/seminar for all stakeholders (similar to that of Norwegian CAA) to share lessons learnt and discuss joint strategies designed to continuously improve the safety standards of Norwegian military aviation. 4	anonymous	Two things: - Keep the MAIBs coming. These are really good and informative I would also like the MAA-NOR to consider implementing some sort of telephone hotline for informal queries, to easily clear up misunderstandings and misinterpretations of the requirements (within regular working hours, of course). Reason being that the MO's are expected to live by the EMAR regulations in their raw and unprocessed form (i.e. no particular "Norwegian" EMAR), which may at times be quite difficult to understand and translate into RNoAF context. Formal requests would still be in writing, of course.
5	anonymous	SMS - Safety Management System for airworthiness and maintenance organisations. Compliance focused regulation iaw EASA present regulation. EMAR regulations for Air Operations, to get a better and more predictable interface between Operations, airworthiness and maintenance based on EASA.
6	anonymous	We need a proper application to manage an SMS, or at least VOR/MORs, audits and authorisations
